Louisiana State Parks Closures: Grand Isle State Park and Cypremort Point State Park closed through the Labor Day weekend because of potentially heavy rainfall from Tropical Storm Lee. Programming at all state parks and state historic sites in south Louisiana is cancelled through the weekend. Officials said Friday that campers who had planned to stay at the closed state parks can get a refund or relocate to another state park.

Damage and Impact Assessments

As of Noon 5 September 2011, the following damage and impact assessments have been submitted by the parishes:

Acadia: 1 home with minimal water damage

Assumption: experiencing some minor flooding in streets and yards

Jefferson: Possible levee breach and overtopping at Boomtown Casino in Harvey. Voluntary evacuation of casino and flood gates closed to protect Harvey and West Jefferson north of the canal

Lafourche: 2 homes reported receiving water, 4 homes damaged due to wind and debris, 1 business sustained damages due to fire

LaSalle: One house sustained damage from a fallen tree

Livingston: 150 homes affected with damage from weather

Orleans: 2 homes sustained various levels of flooding, partial roof collapse due to excess water

Plaquemines: Overtopping and collapse of the Myrtle Grove levee (non-federal back levee)

Rapides: Less than 10 homes with minor damages reported

St. Bernard: 1 home with minor damage and 12 home with minor flooding reported

St. John: One home reported small amount of water

St. Landry: One residence reported minor damage from a fallen tree

St. Mary: 2 RVs received minor damage, 1 home damaged from fallen tree

St. Tammany: 41 homes sustained water damage

Tangipahoa: 8 homes with minor damage

Terrebonne: Multiple homes, 1 apartment and 2 sheds reported impacted by water, over 2000 acres of cane estimated to be affected

West Feliciana: 5 homes received water up to a foot of water with 10 more affected by water
